To Whom It May Concern,

Wonderful Pistachios will announce today that it is voluntarily recalling a limited number of its flavors and sizes of in-shell and shelled pistachios due to a risk of *Salmonella* contamination.

We have been contacted by Center for Disease Control that some of our product may be linked to several cases of *Salmonella*. We are currently working with the FDA to take the necessary steps to recall any product containing the lots of pistachios that may be affected. Further, we are advising consumers to not eat the product and to discard it. We will reimburse any consumers or customers for product losses related to this recall.

Attached is the recall press release, which provides further details including a list of the product impacted. Our team will be in contact with you to communicate the specific lots of affected products that were shipped to you. Attached please find the Wonderful Pistachios “Effectiveness Check” form, which will provide confirmation to the FDA that you have been notified regarding this matter. We would appreciate it if you would sign and return this form to us.

We remain committed to our partnership with you, as well as being stewards of good health for consumers everywhere. As you likely know, this is the first time we have experienced a pistachio recall in our 30-year history, and we take food safety matters such as this one very seriously. To that end, we are working closely with officials to identify the source of this problem and to ensure that this will not happen again.
