We are issuing a product recall for two T.G.I. Friday's products. This is a lower level, Class 2 recall. This means we need to pull product back from you and your customers.

This recall is based on a chance there are tiny metal particles in our seasoning. This issue was caused by an incoming ingredient from our seasoning supplier, Kerry Ingredients and had nothing to do with our manufacturing processes and procedures. These particles were even too small to be picked up by the metal detectors at Kerry's facility as well as our plant.
