Due to three complaints isolated to one production facility, Tyson Foods in collaboration with Chester's Chicken is issuing a **PRODUCT ACTION AND REPLACEMENT** on product 18937-2016 that you purchase from us. These complaints are sensory related; we do not believe there is a food safety concern. Product details are as follows:

Product Code:

- 18937-2016 Tyson/Chester's Chicken Uncooked Breaded Chicken Tenderloin

Production Facility:

- Blountsville (BLV) in Blountsville, Alabama

Production Dates: production date as follows:

- 0134BLV

You can identify these products by using the Tyson Julian date code printed on the mastercase. The Julian date code will begin with 0134BLV followed by four additional numbers that represent line and hour code. A full Julian date code should appear as follows: 0134BLV####. This product action includes all hours of production on these dates.

Dot Foods received and subsequently shipped the Tyson/Chester's product impacted by this product action. At this time, the complaints that drove this product action are limited to a small numbers of Chester's Chicken retailers. Based on our initial findings, we believe this is an isolated issue and not a food safety concern.

Inventory from this product action that is either in Dot inventory or returned to Dot Foods can be donated or destroyed. Upon receipt of proper documentation of disposal or donation, Tyson Foods will issue credit accordingly. We do not plan to pick up any of this product.
